Terms and Conditions:

Game fee is per team. This is to be paid in ONE transaction by the team organiser prior to the game unless the team is invoiced prior for the full competition amount. Arrangements can be made to pay the full game fee by credit card or bank transfer. Individual player payments will not be accepted – NO CASH

Teams that withdraw from the competition will not be refunded. Any team default a scheduled game within 24 hours will be charged a default fee of \$40.

Alcohol is permitted in the indoor centre for people over the age of 18 years. It must be consumed outside of the net area and within indoor centre. Drink responsibly and **DO NOT** drive if you are nearing or are over the legal limit.

All incidents/accidents must be logged via email to Helen Smith (helens@northcricket.co.nz) by close of business on Friday following. Participants need to be fully aware of the health and safety risks that are noted on the health safety signs in the facility.

We ask that all teams respect the fact that indoor cricket is primarily played for social reasons and as such should be played in good spirit and with a measure of self-control. For this reason alone, the "SPIRIT OF THE GAME" will be considered by the Umpire in all decisions that they make. Foul or abusive language, intentional dangerous play, over aggressive play, and a lack of respect for other players personal safety are just some of the examples of what we consider to be detrimental to the "SPIRIT OF THE GAME".
