

Overseas Players/Coaches – NCA Support and Policy 2020-

The NCA is able to support clubs in finding players from overseas in the following manner (by negotiation and/or agreement):

- NCA can provide clubs with contacts (agent details) to contact directly.
- NCA can support clubs by initiating conversations/communication with agents.
- NCA can provide clubs with contacts (player details) to contact directly (if applicable).
- NCA can support clubs by initiating conversations/communication with players (if applicable).
- NCA can support clubs with outlining logistical requirements (costs, travel, accommodation, potential visa applications, paperwork, employment options, PAYE, contracts and finding funding).

NB

- Support is dictated to by how/when clubs approach the NCA and what they require.
- Clubs can find their own overseas players (3 per team maximum).
- The NCA is under no obligation to find overseas players/coaches for clubs – all support is based on negotiation and/or agreement between clubs and the NCA.
- If a player approaches the NCA to play cricket in Northland; all clubs will be emailed by the GM or Competitions Manager, with player contact details and clubs can register their interest in securing the player's services as they see fit.

NCA Player/Coach:

- If the NCA employs an overseas player/coach – the NCA Board will decide on which club that player will play for. There will particular focus on supporting clubs that will strongly benefit from an overseas player/coach.
